Farmers in Shakiso on average have a farm land bigger than most areas at 4 hectares.

Guji is the largest coffee growing region for specialty coffee in Ethiopia. The region possess young coffee trees compared to neighbouring origins such as Yirgacheffe.

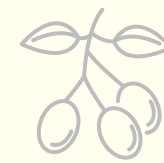
